**Restrictions**

It has been pointed out that there are a few dogs running around loose in the neighborhood, especially at night. Our Deed of Restrictions describes the leash law

for our neighborhood. On page 4, number 19 it says:

**“ANIMALS:** No animal, livestock or poultry of any kind shall be raised, bred or kept on any lot, with the exception of dogs, cats and other household pets (meaning the domestic pets traditionally recognized as household pets in this geographic area), provided that such pets are not kept, bred or maintained for commercial purposes, and **provided that such pets be kept within an enclosed area and not permitted to run or stray upon other lots unless on a leash or under direct control.”**
